Past Activities

As we are in the nascent stages of our development, we currently have the following milestones complete:

1. Registration with the State of California as a 501(c)(3) nonprofit public benefit corporation concentrating on education.
2. Constitution of initial Board of Directors consisting of 4 Directors
3. Appointment of Secretary: Lilia Huayllasco
4. Appointment of Treasurer: Marty Quintanilla
5. Held first annual Amauta Foundation Strategic Offsite
6. Creating amauta-foundation.org web presence and email infrastructure
7. Secured shared office space at 2323 Broadway, Oakland, CA 94612

Current Activities

We are currently starting to network and build out our strategic roadmap. Below is a list of our current work streams with a short description.

1. Legal and Administration - Tasked with completing our tax exempt status with the IRS and State of California. Also tasked with completing requisite forms on a one off or regular basis given need.



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2. Marketing - Tasked with building and promoting our online\social presence by partnering with our Fundraising work stream so as to facilitate future fundraising activities.
3. Fundraising - Currently coming up with a roadmap for fundraising activities
4. Program Curriculum - tasked with the creation of our short, medium, and long term beneficiary programs. These programs will expose underrepresented youth to core STEM fields.
5. Governance - tasked with organizing all work stream activities as a head program office, thereby insuring that all activities are in support of our current mission. Also responsible for the creation of our financial budget projections and monthly \quarterly reporting.

Future Activities

Below is a list of our future activities once we have completed certain milestones:

1. Registration with Tech Soup to receive charitable software after showing tax exempt status.
2. Application to specific grants based on the strategic fundraising roadmap.
3. Indiegogo crowd funding initiative in support of our initial program kickoff in fall of 2014.
4. Development of first program curriculum for fall of 2014 concentrating on Computer Science.
5. Recruitment of teacher\mentors for fall 2014
6. Recruitment of students in Oakland, CA for fall 2014
7. Secure teaching facilities and infrastructure
8. Receive donated laptop computers from local technology and finance companies in the area.
9. Addition of second generation program curriculum covering the following areas:
 1. robotics
 2. data science
 3. quant finance
 4. game theory
